MICROSOFT VISTA AND QUICKBUILDER (DEC 6, 2007)

QuickBuilder requires specific Administrative rights in order to authorize the application. Because of Vista's new security mechanism called User Account Control (UAC), the definition of an Administrator and what rights an Administrator is granted differs slightly compared with Windows XP.

Therefore, additional steps are required when authorizing QuickBuilder under Vista.

The user needs to find the location of the installed application which is usually at: C:\Program Files\Control Technology Corporation\QuickBuilder

The user needs to right-click the application file named "QBApp" and choose "Run as Administrator."

Once the application is launched with full rights and privileges, it can be authorized.

Note: The user can run QuickBuilder the "normal way" (i.e. using the Start Menu or the desktop shortcut) after authorization.
